Help to stop it spreading Say no to Noro

We have been asked to bring the issues of Norovirus to the attention of our school communities. Norovirus or 'Winter vomiting bug' can spread quickly and can close schools, hospitals and care homes. If you or your child has had sickness or diarrhoea it is crucial that they stop away from school for 48 hours since the last episode of sickness occurred. One of the best ways to stop Norovirus from spreading is to step up your hygiene routines and ensure thorough handwashing after using the toilet and always before eating.
