Dear Parents/Carers,

Ofsted Inspection Report – 19th October 2017

Following the Ofsted Inspection of the school prior to half term please find attached a copy of the letter sent to the school. As the school was previously rated as 'Good' we received a 'Short Inspection' and as such a full report is not produced as was the case with our 2014 inspection.

We are delighted with the outcomes of the inspection and can confirm the school remains a '**Good**' school overall; which is a fantastic achievement considering the recent changes to the inspection regime and with the threshold for 'GOOD' being much more difficult to attain than when the school was previously inspected in 2014. We are very proud of all that the school has achieved with many of these attributes being recognised in the report which states that **'the good quality of education has been maintained since the last inspection'**. The report also recognises that Glenfall is **'inclusive and supportive'** and that parents are **'overwhelmingly positive about the education that their children receive'**. The work that the school has undertaken in developing the teaching of mathematics was also acknowledged by the inspector who states that **'the changes have been very successful'**

The academic successes of the children at the end of KS1 and KS2 in 2017 should also be celebrated alongside this report. The children performed particularly well last year and in all cases the school achieved levels above those achieved locally and nationally. Progress in KS2 was in the top 25% nationally this year and we feel that this is as a result of excellent teaching and the firm foundation which is established in the EYFS and into KS1 which is further built on and sustained throughout KS2.


