

## Mathematics

We will continue with our work on Addition and Subtraction initially, working towards adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers and solving problems. We will then move on to Multiplication and Division where our focus will be the 2, 5 and 10 times tables and related division facts. The children will also complete their work on capacity before moving on to learning about Money. The children will learn to recognise the different coins and how to make amounts using different combinations of coins.

## FOREST SCHOOL

There will be Forest School on Friday afternoons this half term.

Please send your child to school with appropriate clothes, including wellies and a coat, in a named bag. It is also helpful if each of the individual items are named!



## Music

All inspired by our Into the Woods topic the children will study various musical pieces, which include 'Peter and the Wolf', 'Teddy Bears' Picnic' and 'In and Out the Dusty Bluebells'. We will become familiar with the various characters presented and enjoy singing expressively. We will also learn to recognise some instruments of the orchestra and instrument families.



## Art & Design

We will be completing a number of art projects which will use a number of skills including mark marking, sketching and collage, whilst using felt tips, pastels, paints and paper. The children will also follow a recipe to bake cupcakes for Grandma using Red Riding Hood's recipe.



## English

Our English work will focus around 'Little Red Riding Hood' this term. We will work together to learn a story telling version of the story work towards being able to retell it. The children will write character descriptions, setting descriptions and letters as they work towards writing a new version of the story.



## RE

We will complete our work learning about how Muslims live this half term. This will include learning about how and why they pray and about how and why they celebrate Eid-ul-Fitr.

## PSHE

In our PSHE lessons we will progress our understanding about making choices and keeping safe. The children will learn to talk about recent choices they have made and what influenced them.

## ICT

In ICT we will develop our understanding of algorithms and how they are used to give a set of instructions, on digital devices. We will design our own sequence of commands, such as getting ready to visit the woods. We will learn how to improve our algorithms and give more precise instructions.

# Into the Woods

## PE

Gymnastics will be our focus for one of our PE sessions. The children will explore different ways of travelling, balancing, jumping and rolling. They will practise to improve these movements and then work together to create and perform a sequence in pairs. We will also continue to have Miss Clayson, our coach from MoveMore in on a Tuesday afternoon to take the other PE session.

## Science

In Science our focus will be on plants. The children will learn to identify the main features of a plant, as well as explain a plant's lifecycle. Then we will investigate different types of seeds and learn about conditions for plant growth. There will be opportunities to set up a fair test and interpret findings.
