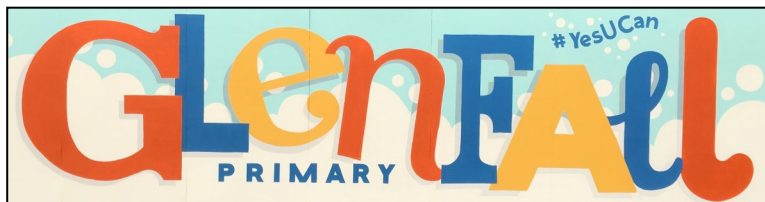
Last weekend was the Summer Fair, which again was another well attended event in beautiful sunshine.

Firstly we would like to thank all of the families that supported the summer school fair and raffle. We raised a fantastic:

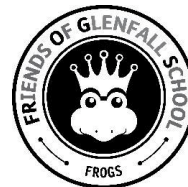
