
Glenfall's first 'Poetry Slam.' Each class prepared a poem to perform to each other in a face to face performance



Check to see if your child is eligible using the confidential online portal available on our website www.gloucestershire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals

You can secure a tasty free meal for your child and save yourself up to $\pounds 437$ per year.

Plus your child's school receives extra funding for each eligible child registered



If you receive a qualifying benefit, your child's school is entitled to extra funding.

So even if you don't want your child to take a free meal, you should still apply to make sure that their school receives all the government funding to which it is entitled - helping them provide your child with the best education and support.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 already receiving an Universal Infant Free School Meal arranged by their school will still have to apply to enable their chool to get any extra funding.

If you do not have access to a computer or the internet, speak to your child's school.

Parent Pay — School Lunches

Could all parents whose children will be taking a hot lunch please ensure that their accounts are currently in credit before ordering lunches. It is important that the account is kept in credit throughout the year to ensure that debts do not mount up. **Meals cost** £2.30 per day. The current menu remains in place until October half term.



Y6 Secondary School Transfer

The deadline for making your choices for secondary school transfer is 31st October. Please make your application <u>online</u>. If you have not received a letter please contact the school office. It is crucial for all Y6 parents to apply for a secondary school place even if you have another child at the school to which you will be applying.

Bikeability

Bikeability starts for Y6 on 12th November. You should have received letters regarding this activity. Half term would be a good opportunity to check that your child's bike is roadworthy.




World War 1 Memorial March
