A Positive Approach to Behaviour Management

Adult Behaviour...

- 1. Stay calm try not to get emotionally involved
- 2. Model the behaviour you expect
- 3. Don't take it personally
- 4. Give them (and you) time to calm down
- 5. Catch them being good

Actions ...

- 1. Reward attitude and effort with house points.
- 2. Speak to parents to celebrate successes
- 3. Use classroom behaviour ladder to manage negative behaviour

- Quick warning
- Quick consequence/follow up
- Inform the class teacher

- What can we do to put things right?
- How can we do things differently in the future?
