A Positive Approach to Behaviour Management

Adult Behaviour...

1. Stay calm – try not to get emotionally involved
2. Model the behaviour you expect
3. Don't take it personally
4. Give them (and you) time to calm down
5. Catch them being good

Actions ...

1. Reward attitude and effort with house points.
2. Speak to parents to celebrate successes
3. Use classroom behaviour ladder to manage negative behaviour

CHALLENGING MISBEHAVIOUR

In the classroom

- Use the behaviour ladder

In the playground

- Quick warning
- Quick consequence/follow up
- Inform the class teacher

RESTORATIVE QUESTIONS

- What happened?
- Why did this happen?
- Who has been affected and how did they feel?
- What can we do to put things right?
- How can we do things differently in the future?
