



Glenfall Primary School has been asked by The Department for Education (DFE) to fully open the school to all pupils from September 2020.

To enable this to happen safely and effectively, our home to school agreement has to be altered.

We (school) will:

- Carry out a thorough risk assessment to enable us to make what we feel is the right decision regarding a planned re-opening (this might vary to other schools).
- Do everything that we can to minimise risk e.g. smaller groupings, staggered drop off and pick up times, staggered break and lunchtimes, alteration of classrooms and use of resources.
- Ensure that our staff maintain a high level of personal hygiene, in particular with regards to handwashing.
- Ensure that we encourage the children to wash their hands regularly and for at least 20 seconds.
- Ensure that a member of school staff sits with your child if they are poorly while we are waiting for them to be collected (please note that school staff may need to wear personal protective equipment [PPE]) at this time.

You (parents) will:

- Understand that even with a variety of procedures put in place to limit risk, social distancing is not possible in a primary school.
- Stick to the allocated group and related drop off and collection times.
- Make sure that your child only brings in essential items for the school day ( a water bottle, their lunchbox, a healthy snack, coat to school each day, PE Kit, Wellies & clothes for Forest School)
- Collect your child immediately if your child shows any symptoms of illness on site.
- Collect your child immediately if your child behaves in a way that puts themselves or others at risk; we will be unable to use normal de-escalation techniques or those involving positive handling.
