I hope that you all have a good weekend.

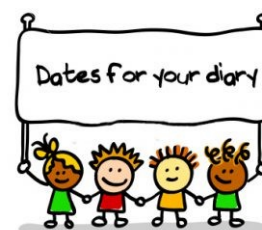
