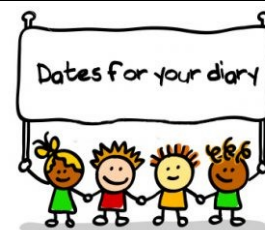

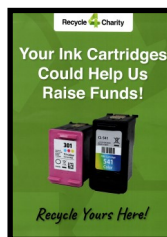
Calling all Graphic Designers...
