Ofsted Inspection Report

Following the Ofsted Inspection of the school in July, please find attached a copy of the report.

We are delighted with the outcomes of the inspection and can confirm the school remains a **'Good'** school overall; which is a fantastic achievement considering the recent changes to the inspection regime. We are very proud of all that the school has achieved with many of these attributes being recognised in the report. As a school, we offer a full and balanced curriculum and are immensely proud of the many opportunities for enrichment that we offer in addition to the academic rigour in the core subjects for **all** children. The inspection identified that; ***"The curriculum is ambitious. Subject-by subject, leaders are adding depth and richness. As a result, pupils' learning is moving beyond the requirements of the national curriculum."***

The children have many opportunities to **Enjoy – Enquire – Excel** and become well rounded individuals who go from strength to strength as they move through the school and onwards into their secondary education.

The schools support for pupils with SEN was also recognised, stating that; ***"Leaders go to substantial lengths to make sure that pupils achieve their targets and make the progress of which they are capable."***

The academic successes of the children at the end of KS1 and KS2 in 2023 should also be celebrated alongside this report. The children performed well last year and in all cases the school achieved levels above those achieved locally and nationally.
