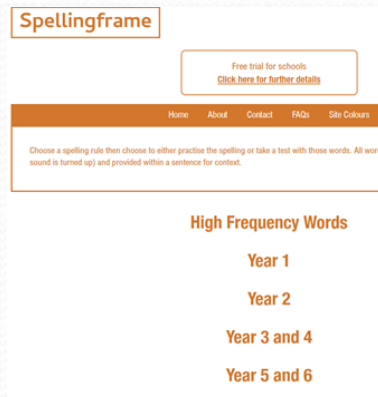


Homework
